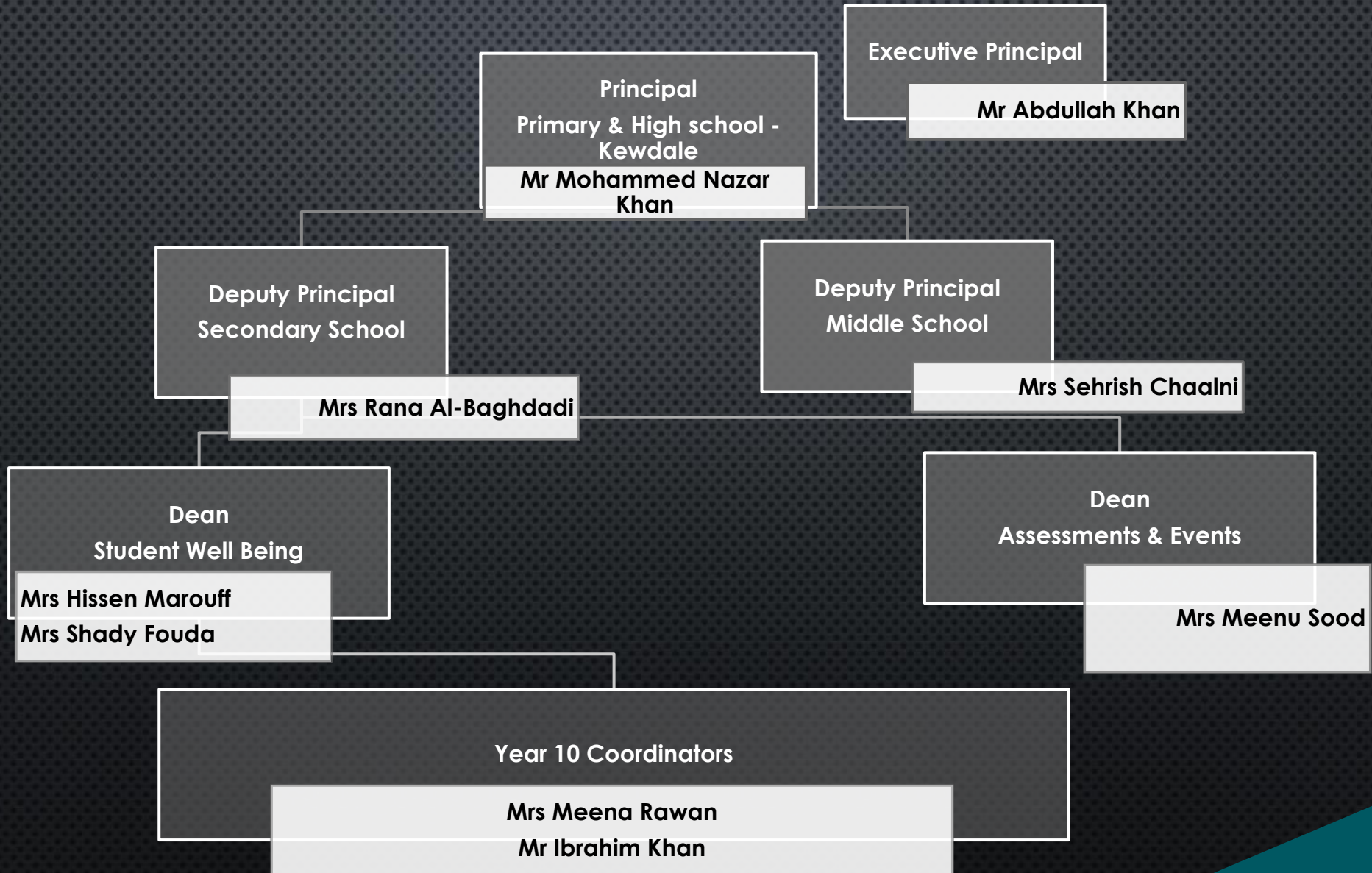

# An overview of Year 10

## What's expected of students in Year 10



Year 10 students must have a solid grasp of the fundamental concepts of their subjects in preparation for Year 11.



Students must prepare for the following when transitioning into Year 10:

- They must expect an increase in conceptual difficulty as the modules/topics become more challenging to understand;
- They must expect an increase in workload as it takes longer for homework completion;
- They must be more self-directed in their learning;
- They must assess which subject(s) to continue for their studies in Year 11.
