General requirements

You must:

- demonstrate a minimum standard of literacy (reading and writing) and a minimum standard of numeracy
- complete a minimum of 20 units, or equivalents
- complete
 - at least four Year 12 ATAR courses OR
 - at least five Year 12 General courses and/or ATAR courses or equivalent OR
 - a Certificate II (or higher) VET qualification in combination with ATAR, General or Foundation courses.

Literacy and numeracy standard

For the WACE literacy and numeracy standard you may:

- pre-qualify through achieving Band 8 or higher in the reading, numeracy tests of the Year 9 National Assessment Program – Numeracy (NAPLAN), or;
- demonstrate the minimum standard of literacy and numeracy successfully completing the relevant components of the Onlin Numeracy Assessment (OLNA) in Year 10, 11 or 12.

Breadth and depth

3

You must complete a minimum of 20 units, which may include unit equivale attained through VET and/or endorsed programs. This requirement must include at least:

- a minimum of ten Year 12 units, or the equivalent
- four units from an English course, post-Year 10, including at least one pai Year 12 units from an English learning area course
- one pair of Year 12 units from each of List A (arts/languages/social scienc and List B (mathematics/science/technology) subjects.

Achievement standard

You must achieve at least 14 C grades or higher (or equivalents) in Year 11 and Year 12 units, including at least six C grades (or equivalents) in Year 12 units.

Unit equivalents

Unit equivalents can be obtained through VET qualit programs. The maximum number of unit equivalent and endorsed programs is four Year 11 units and fou maximum of four units with endorsed programs – tv Year 12.


