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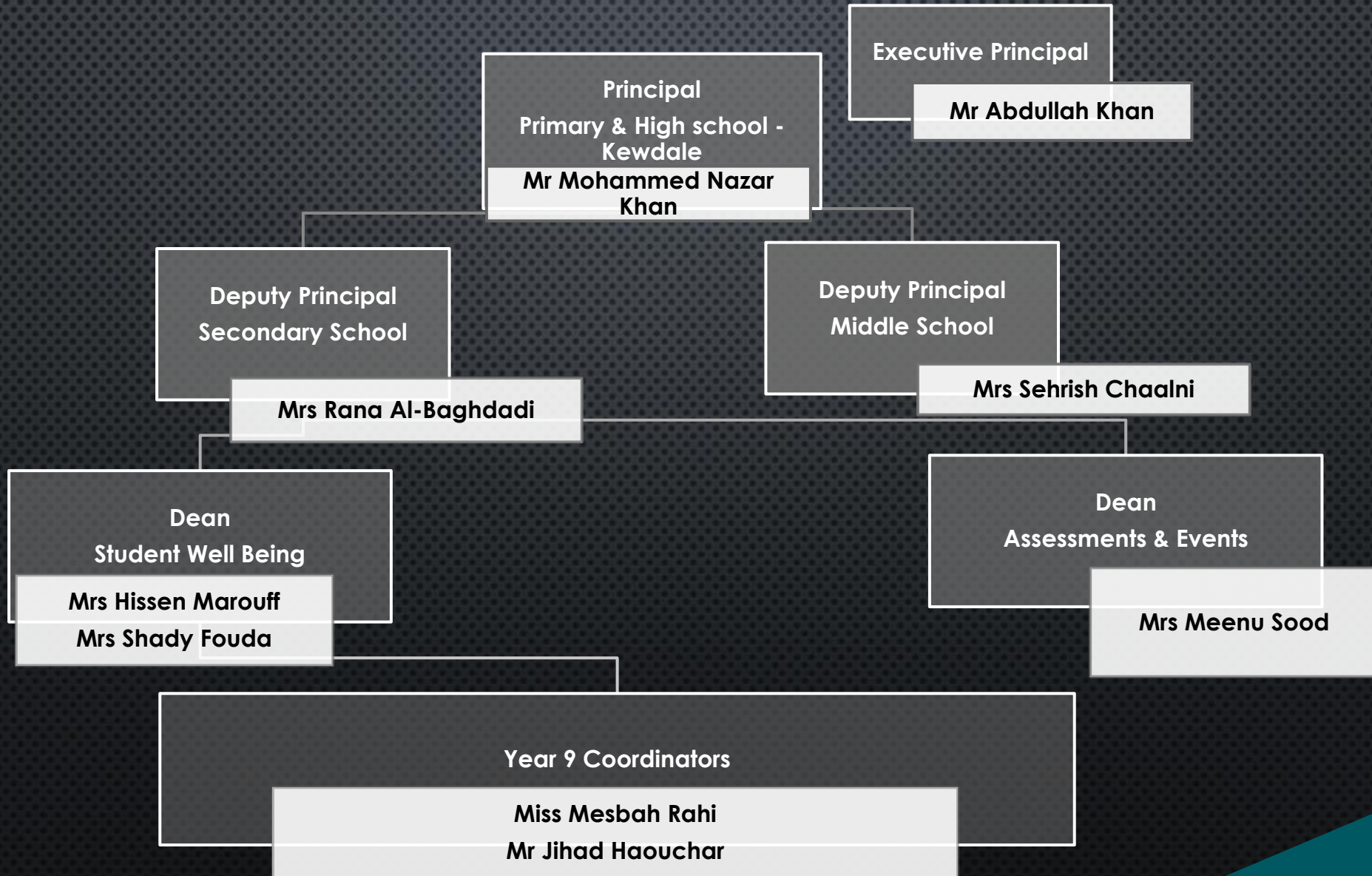

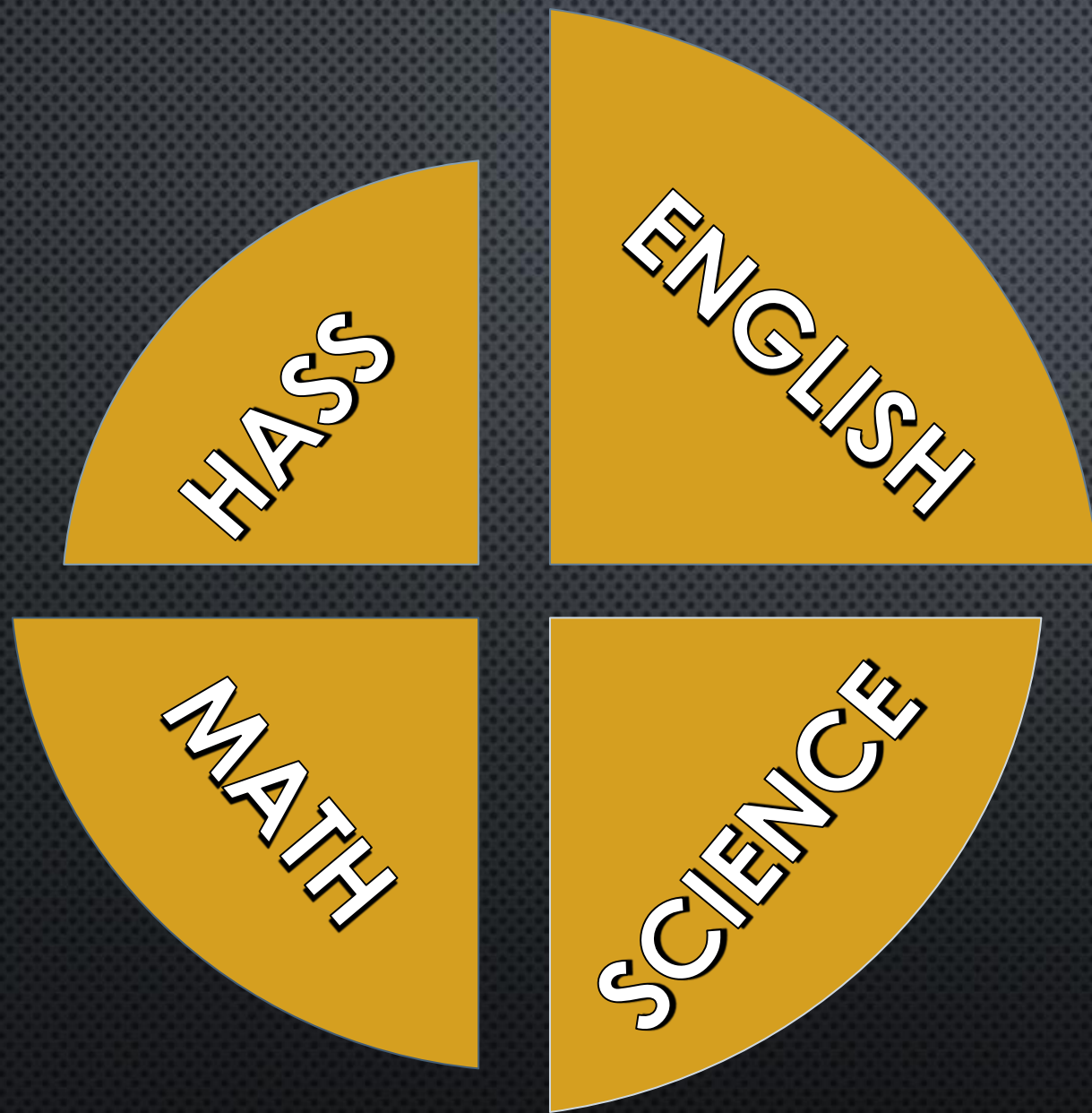

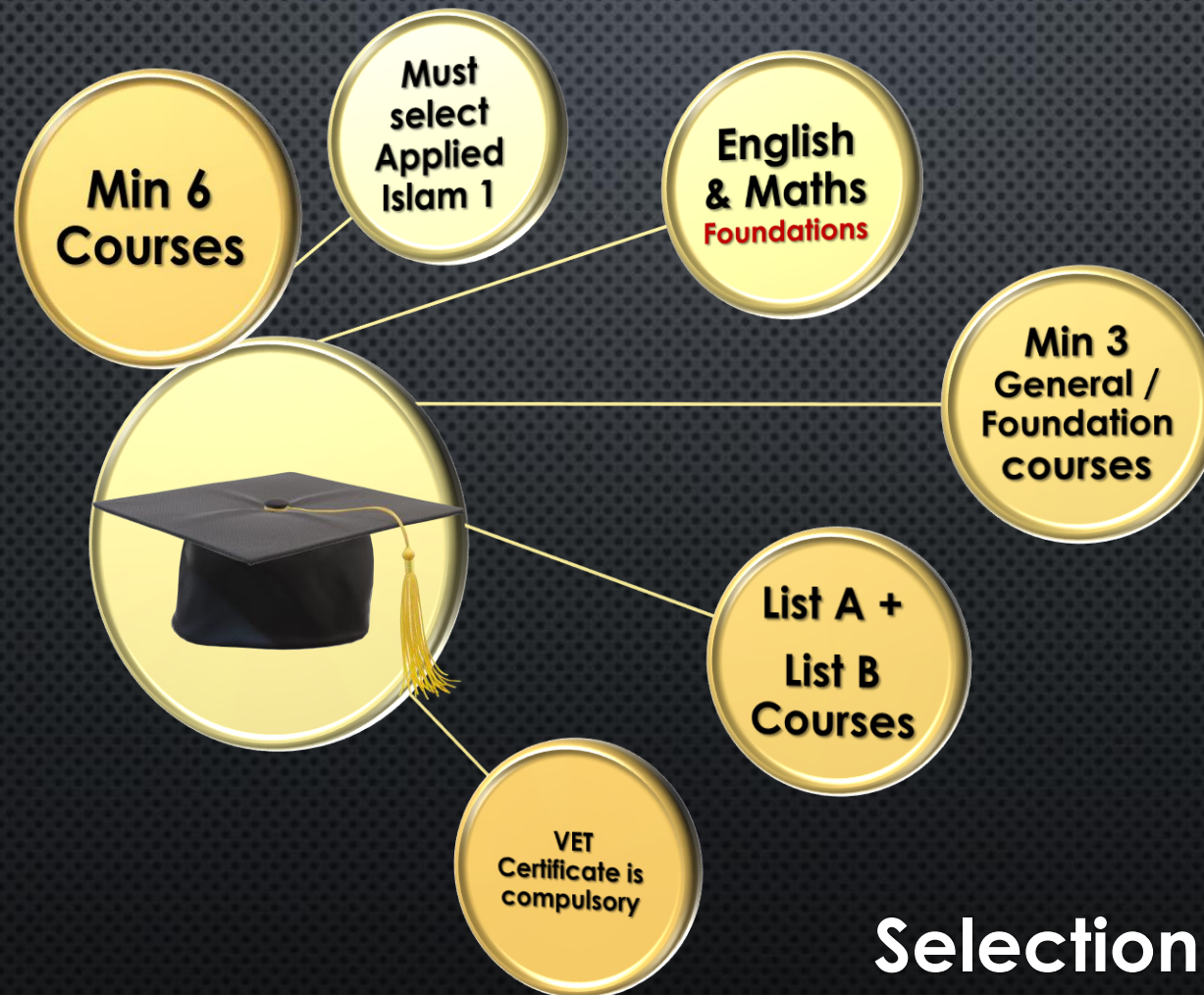

- ACCEPTANCE INTO OVER 100 COURSES BETWEEN ECU, MURDOCH AND CURTIN UNIVERSITIES

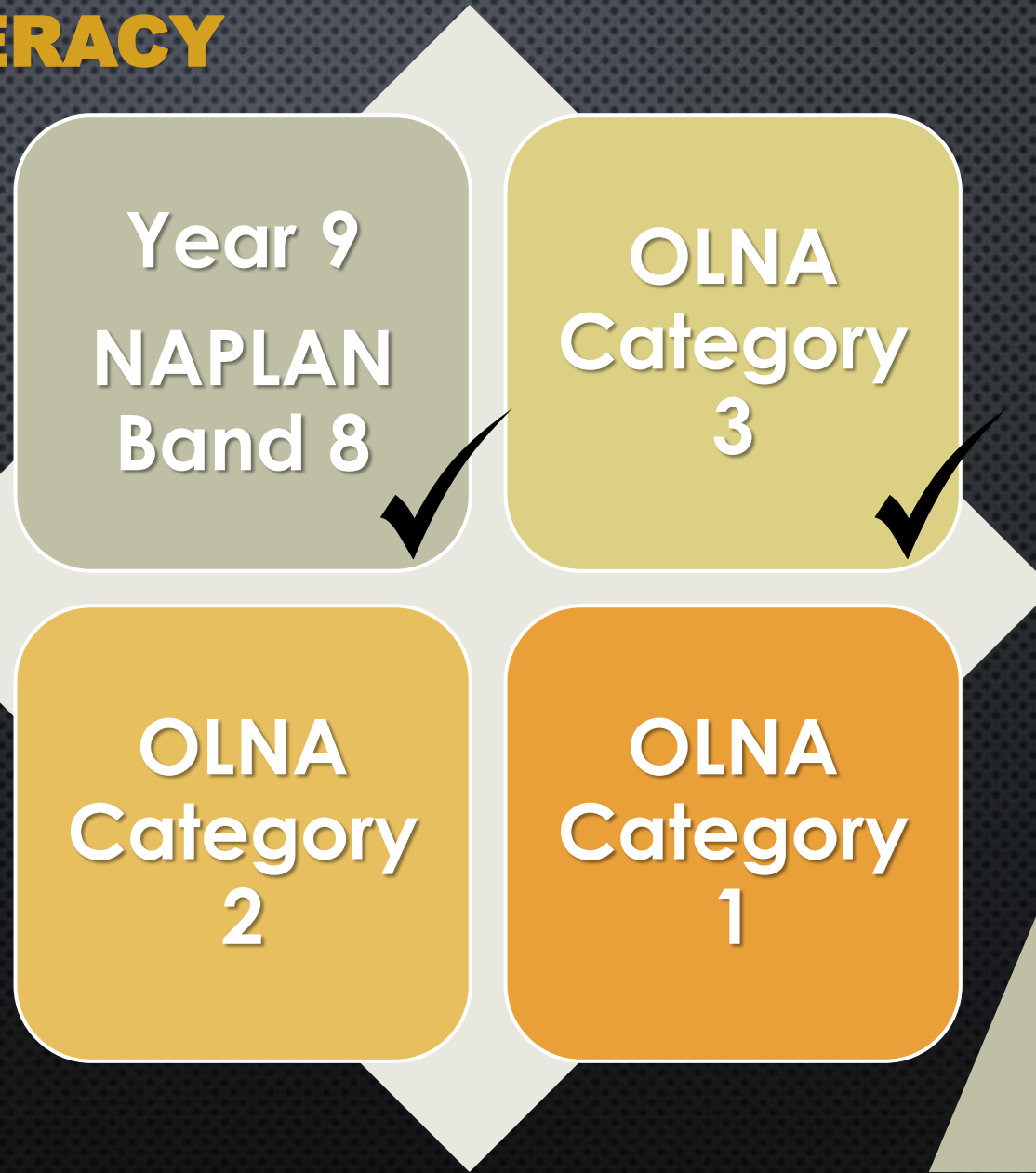

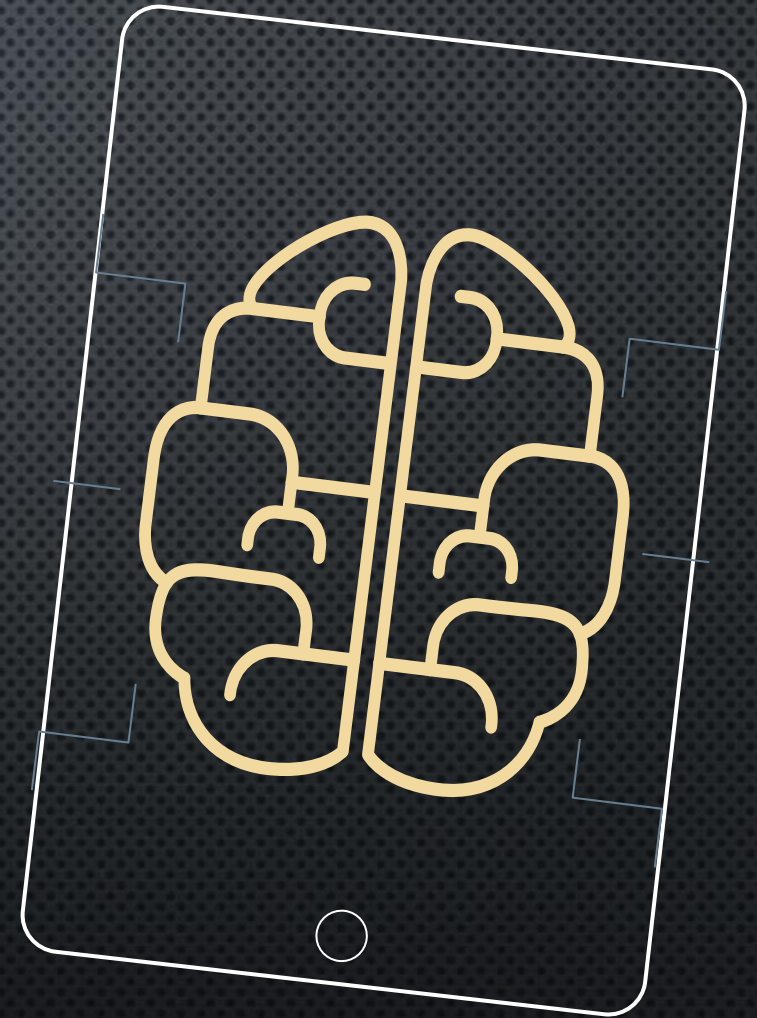


